- One of the ways he does this is to ask children what they think.










Quick facts about the kids that filled in the survey








We asked you what the main reasons were for you not doing an activity you wanted to do.




We asked you what you mainly do in your spare time? You told us...

- 'I think we as kids don't miss out on activities.'


